ORANGE COUNTY ARTS GRANT PROGRAM

Trustee Carnright made a motion authorizing the Mayor to apply for funds for the Village of Cornwall-on-Hudson bandstand concerts program through the Orange County Arts Grant Program which was seconded by Trustee Russell and carried upon a vote of 4 Ayes and 0 Nays.

ORANGE COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT GRANTS

Mayor Coyne made a motion to schedule a public hearing on May 20, 2013 at 7:02 p.m. in order to discuss the 2014 Community Development Block Grant Program which was seconded by Trustee Kane and carried upon a vote of 4 Ayes and 0 Nays.

Discussion followed regarding development of a plan to provide handicap access to the Riverfront Shelter at Donahue Memorial Park and an application for funds through the Community Development Block Grant Program to cover associated costs.
