Mayor Coyne made a motion to call to order a special meeting of the Board of Trustees at 8:20 P.M., at 325 Hudson St., Cornwall-on-Hudson, N.Y. which was seconded by Trustee Carnright and carried upon a vote of 4 Ayes and 0 Nays.

DPW LABORER POSITION/APPOINTMENT

Upon the recommendation of DPW Superintendent Halvorsen, Mayor Coyne made a motion to appoint James Moore to the vacant Laborer position in the Department of Public Works at the salary in the current union contract. The appointment is subject to a one year probation, a background and license check, a physical examination and all other prescribed tests. Further the appointment is effective upon completion of all required items. The motion was seconded by Trustee Carnright and carried upon a vote of 4 Ayes and 0 Nays.

SUMMER HELP

Upon the recommendation of DPW Superintendent Halvorsen, Mayor Coyne made a motion to hire Jack Storer as a summer help laborer in the Department of Public Works not to exceed 24 hours per week, for a period not to exceed 6 months, and at the same rate of pay as last year (\$14.00 per hr). The effective date will be set by DPW Superintendent Halvorsen upon completion of all pre-employment requirements. The motion was seconded by Trustee Schmidt and carried upon a vote of 4 Ayes and 0 Nays.

Upon the recommendation of Water Superintendent June, Mayor Coyne made a motion to hire Michael Donato as a summer help laborer in the Water Department not to exceed 24 hours per week, for a period not to exceed 6 months, and at the same rate of pay as last year (\$14.00 per hr). The effective date will be set by Water Superintendent June upon completion of all pre-

employment requirements. The motion was seconded by Trustee Schmidt and carried upon a vote of 4 Ayes and 0 Nays.

Having concluded the business set before them, Deputy Mayor Edsall moved to adjourn the Special Meeting at 8:27 PM which was seconded by Trustee Schmidt and carried by a vote of 4 Ayes and 0 Nays.
