

VILLAGE OF CORNWALL-ON-HUDSON BOARD OF TRUSTEES

January 29, 2018

A Special Meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to order at 5:30 P.M., with the Pledge of Allegiance, at 325 Hudson St., Cornwall-on-Hudson, N.Y.

2018 – 2019 BUDGET ADOPTION

Mayor Coyne introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption.

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING MARCH 1, 2018 AND ENDING FEBRUARY 28, 2019, MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CONDUCT OF VILLAGE GOVERNMENT AND ESTABLISHING THE RATES OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES FOR SUCH PERIOD.

WHEREAS, the tentative budget for the year commencing March 1, 2018 and ending February 28, 2019 has been duly presented to the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cornwall-on-Hudson by the Budget Officer and a duly advertised Public Hearing has been held thereon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to Section 5-508(4) of the Village Law, that the tentative budget as amended and revised, be and hereby is adopted as the budget and all amounts set forth in Statement 1 as required for the payment of principal of and interest on indebtedness be and are hereby appropriated for the objects and purposes specified and the salaries and wages stated in the schedule of such budget shall be and are hereby fixed at the amounts shown therein effective March 1, 2018.

The foregoing resolution was seconded by Trustee Carnright and carried upon a vote of 4 Ayes and 0 Nays.

TAX LEVY RESOLUTION

Mayor Coyne introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption.

A RESOLUTION LEVYING THE TOTAL TAXES AND OTHER CHARGES EXTENDED AND LEVIED AGAINST EACH PARCEL OF REAL PROPERTY SHOWN ON THE ROLL PREPARED AND VERIFIED BY THE ASSESSOR FOR THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR.

RESOLVED, that there be levied and assessed against the real property of the Village of Cornwall-on-Hudson the following sums for village government and other charges for the fiscal year 2018-19 with a tax rate of \$7.43 per thousand of assessed valuation:

The foregoing resolution was seconded by Trustee Carnright and the motion was carried upon a vote of 4 Ayes and 0 Nays.

2018 – 2019 WATER, SEWER, AND GARBAGE RATES

Mayor Coyne made a motion to set the 2018 – 2019 rates for Water, Sewer and Garbage as follows:

The Town of Cornwall water rate will increase by \$0.44 to \$15.00 (per 1,000 gallons consumed).

The Village of Cornwall-on-Hudson water rate will increase by \$1.44 to \$11.00 (per 1,000 gallons consumed).

The Village Sewer Rate will be 103% of the water charge.

The Village Garbage rate will remain the same at:
