Village Summer Recreation Program starts July 5

The Village of Cornwall-on-Hudson will operate its Summer Recreation Program for six weeks, from July 5 through Aug. 11.

The recreation program runs from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday through Friday at Cornwall-on-Hudson elementary school. The program is open to children who will enter grades K-7 next autumn. The program offers games, sports, arts and crafts, swimming, special activities and field trips.

Registration will be held from 10 a.m. to noon June 10 and from 6-8 p.m. June 12 in the village hall board room. Parents and guardians must bring a form of identification indicating their address. They must also prove an up-to-date immunization record from the their children's health provider.

Jennifer Borland is returning as the director and Jenna Park, a counselor for several years, is the assistant director.

The fee for Cornwall-on-Hudson residents is \$150 per child (\$325 maximum per family). The fee for non-village residents is \$250 per child.

The field trips, which require additional fees, include Storm King Art Center, Splashdown, Tarsio Bowling Lanes and the Storm King Engine Firemen's Fair.
