**RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE BOARD
OF THE VILLAGE OF CORNWALL-ON-HUDSON
ADOPTING A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 155
OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF
CORNWALL-ON-HUDSON ESTABLISHING A NO
PARKING AT ANY TIME AREA FOR CERTAIN
LENGTHS OF HUDSON STREET WEST OF ACADEMY
AVENUE AND A NO PARKING AT ANY TIME AREA
FOR CERTAIN LENGTHS OF HUDSON STREET WEST
OF CHERRY AVENUE**

WHEREAS, an Introductory local law entitled "A Local Law Amending Chapter 155 of the Village Code of the Village of Cornwall-on-Hudson Establishing a No Parking Area for Certain Lengths of Hudson Street West of Academy Avenue and a Time Limit Parking Area for Certain Lengths of Hudson Street West of Cherry Avenue" was introduced by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cornwall-on-Hudson on March 21, 2016 and upon notice duly published and posted, a hearing was held on April 18, 2016 before the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, based upon comments received from the public, an amendment was made to the proposed local law that modified the proposed "time limit parking" area west of Cherry Avenue to "a no parking any time" area west of Cherry Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing on the proposed local law was continued on May 16, 2016 and June 20, 2016 to provide the public with an opportunity to comment on the proposed amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is the Lead Agency with respect to the consideration, review and determination of the significance of the aforementioned legislative action pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) regulation section 617.6(b)(1)(i); and

WHEREAS, public comments were received by the Board of Trustees at such hearings concerning the merits and environmental impacts of said introductory local law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that upon due consideration of comments received from the public and examination of potential impacts within the relevant areas of environmental concern, the adoption of said Introductory local law is hereby determined not to pose any significant adverse impacts on the environment and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Short Environmental Assessment Form (“SEAF”) prepared in connection with the proposed action; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Introductory Local Law entitled "A Local Law Amending Chapter 155 of the Village Code of the Village of Cornwall-on-Hudson Establishing a No Parking at Any Time Area for Certain Lengths of Hudson Street West of Academy Avenue and a No Parking At Any Time Area for Certain Lengths of Hudson Street West of Cherry Avenue" of the Village of Cornwall-on-Hudson be and hereby is adopted as Local Law #1 of 2016 of the Village of Cornwall-on-Hudson on July 18, 2016.
